
## Health Risk Assessment (HRA): Regional Report Back



## Workshop summary

- All 55 counties completed the assessment, including the data entry
- Total number of participants: ~465
  - Range: 1-30
  - Average: 8 (5.5 external to health dept.)
  - Median: 7 (5 external to health dept.)



## Partner participation in counties

- Hospitals\*: 34/43 (**79%**)
- OES/OEM/911: 43/55 (**78%**)
- Other healthcare: 29/55 (52%)
- Behavioral health: 28/55 (**50%**)
- NGO/FBO: 17/55 (**31%**)
- First responders: 16/55 (**29%**)
- Education/Schools: 15/55 (27%)

#### 49% Public Health Respondents, 51% Other

- Windstorm comparisons





#### Perceived value of the HRA






## HRA used to identify plan strengths









## HRA used to identify plan gaps








### HRA useful for planning






#### HRA useful for exercises








## Useful in meeting grant deliverables


